

## Who did it?

A guessing game using physical descriptions

1. Spread out the 10 pictures in the packet on the table in a place where everyone can see them.
2. These pictures are pictures of people who are suspected of committing a crime. Your job is to discover who did the crime by listening to the detective's description. Once you are certain that you know who the criminal is, please say so. If your guess is a correct one, you will be the next detective.
3. To determine who is the first detective, read the enclosed card. The first group member to correctly identify the criminal is your first detective.
4. Play until everyone has had a chance to be the detective.
